



Akfen Renewable Energy Renews ISO 26000 Social Responsibility Standard Certificate

Akfen Renewable Energy has earned the renewal of the ISO 26000 Social Responsibility standard, which serves as a guideline for providing guidance in the field of social responsibility. Through the ISO 26000 Social Responsibility standard, Akfen Renewable Energy aims for all its activities to adhere to international ethical principles, environmental and legal standards, as well as cultural and political diversity.

Additionally, Akfen Renewable Energy, in collaboration with the Turkey Human Resources Education and Health Foundation (TİKAV), which was also founded by Akfen Holding, develops national projects aimed at people living in areas where energy production facilities are located. As part of the project, face-to-face training was provided on various topics to a total of 6,800 women in four different social responsibility projects.

Akfen Renewable Energy, with its 700 MW installed capacity solely from local and renewable sources such as solar, water, and wind, aims not only for energy production but also for combating climate change, preserving biodiversity, and enhancing environmental and social management while improving the living standards of stakeholders in the regions where it operates.

In this context, the company has earned the right to renew the ISO 26000 Social Responsibility standard, which is developed to provide guidance on social responsibility for organizations. Through the ISO 26000 Social Responsibility standard, Akfen Renewable Energy aims for all its activities to adhere to international ethical principles, environmental and legal standards, as well as cultural and political diversity.

Reaching 6,800 women on various subjects through four different social responsibility projects, Akfen Renewable Energy, in collaboration with the Turkey Human Resources Education and Health Foundation (TİKAV), develops projects for people living in the regions where energy production facilities are located.

In 2017, the "We Became Schools at Home" project reached 800 women in 15 regions regarding the development of children aged 0-6. In 2018, under the theme determined as health, the "Health Comes First" project provided health education to 1,500 women in 17 regions. With the start of the "Hygiene is Health" project in 2019, 2,000 women were reached in 26 different locations, and after the pandemic, the "Savings in Our Homes, Future in Our Hands" project provided education to 2,500

women. Thus, a total of 6,800 women were provided with face-to-face training on various subjects through four different social responsibility projects. The number of indirectly reached individuals exceeded 20,000.

Finally, as part of the developed "Savings in Our Homes, Future in Our Hands" project, meetings were held with women in Mersin, Anamur, Aydın, Karacasu, and Bozdoğan in Aydın, Acıpayam, and Kale in Denizli, Seydikemer and Ula in Muğla, Aziziye in Erzurum, Central in Elazığ, Sarayönü and Ereğli in Konya, Yahyalı in Kayseri, Gemerek in Sivas, Turhal in Tokat, Central in Amasya, Dereli and Bulancak in Giresun, Köprübaşı in Trabzon, Edremit in Van, Gevye in Sakarya, and Central and Lapseki in Çanakkale.

Established under Akfen Holding in 2007, Akfen Renewable Energy A.Ş. initiated Turkey's first renewable energy platform, investing in sustainable energy from entirely indigenous and renewable sources. In 2016, the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD) and the International Finance Corporation (IFC) became partners in the company, and following a share transfer on January 18, 2023, Akfen Holding became the sole owner of the company's shares. Akfen Renewable Energy has a balanced portfolio of hydro, wind, and solar electricity production with a capacity of approximately 700 MW, strategically located in regions with the most suitable natural resources for each technology in 18 provinces across Turkey. Following the initial public offering held in March 2023, the company's shares (33.5% of the total capital) started trading on Borsa Istanbul with the code AKFYE as of March 16, 2023.
